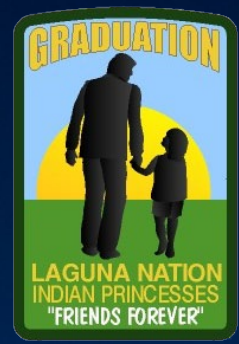


Laguna Nation Indian Princess
