Nation Registration

- Nation Registration as of 4/1/10 – 274

- **Joshua Tree – 5/14 -16**
 - Chippewa is hosting
 - Registration as of 4/1/10
 - 36 people (30 Zuni's & 6 Mono's)
 - Maximum – 265
 - Current members guaranteed a spot through 4/15/10.
 - Alumni & Guest can register after 4/15/10.
 - Nation Chief to email update/status on 4/16/10
 - Chippewa Chief Updates
 - Flyer & Patch should be ready by 4/7/10

 - Shoshone and Canalino are the Host Tribes
 - Registration as of 4/1/10
 - 45 people
 - Early registration incentives:

 - Register between April 16 – May 28th - \$210 per person
 - Front of the line passes for tribe that registers the largest percentage of its tribe the earliest.

 - Mono 14 of 40 (35%)
 - Sioux 2 of 20 (10%)
 - Confirm Minimum / Maximum occupancy
