Nation Registration

 - “Front of Line Pass” Incentive

 - Please discuss with your tribes so they are aware of the incentive and to discuss this with their daughters to prevent issues with what might appear as “cutting in line”.

Y-Princess Program Conversion

- Had an initial meeting with YMCA to discuss the transition strategy from Indian Princess to Adventure theme.
- John & Brent to Update
 - The transition is NOT due to legal or political issues!!!!
 - The YMCA is choosing to go away from the Native American theme because some Native Americans are not happy with how we represent their culture. The YMCA has graciously changed themes because it will make Native Americans happy and it doesn't impact what the program truly means. PERIOD.
 - If there are members who are upset because of our transition, please have them contact me (john C.).
 - YMCA will provide a document at the end of January to help us make the transition
 - The leadership team agreed to make the initial transition this year. How deep we go with it is still undetermined.
 - It was agreed that we need to have a theme for our Expedition (Nation) that our circles (tribes) can name themselves after. The theme will be confirmed by next longhouse so tribes can start thinking of a new name for their circle (tribe).
